- 2. Discussed approval of the amended and restated interlocal equipment from the City of McAllen and MISD District Tennis Facility. It was mentioned that students be given preference in the day time.
- 3. Milam project was approved with a 5-0 vote. Farias left the meeting.
- 4. Discussed resurfacing of tennis courts for Brown, Morris, and Rowe.
- 5. Discussed running track overlay and repair at Memorial. Bid rejected 5-0.

The PCI Clinic is working well and helping with the surplus we need to protect us from new changes we don't understand.
